Banners, signs, business cards and other marketing materials are welcomed. Banners must be displayed inside your assigned stalls. Marketing materials may be distributed until the start of the auction itself; however, we urge discretion and propriety when distributing these materials.

Sunday, May 16th - Alpaca owners are urged to transport their alpacas to the place of agistment or residence.

PENNSYLVANIA REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS

All alpacas must be micro-chipped and ARI registered. All alpacas shall be identified on all health documents by their name and micro-chip number.

BVD TESTING REQUIRED

All alpacas entered in or present at this event must be negative for BVDV by a PCR or VI lab test and said negative results shall be indicated on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) (Health Papers).

The following are the test requirements for the state of Pennsylvania:

(1) Brucellosis:

(i) Camelids which are 12 months of age and older (except neutered males) are test eligible.

(ii) Test-eligible camelids shall be brucellosis test negative within the 60 days prior to the date of entry into Pennsylvania and shall be accompanied to the destination by written certification signed by an accredited veterinarian. This certificate shall include all test results and dates of those tests. This certificate shall include all test results and dates of those tests.

(2) Tuberculosis:

(i) Camelids of any age are test eligible.

(ii) All camelids shall be tuberculosis test negative within the 90 days prior to the date of entry into Pennsylvania and shall be accompanied to the destination by written certification from an accredited veterinarian. This certificate shall include all test results and dates of those tests.


AUCTION TERMS

The Illusion Ranch Alpaca Auction Terms and Conditions

1. I hereby enter the listed alpaca(s) in the Illusion Ranch Alpaca Auction. Consignments will be at least 6 months old.
2. Consignors are to furnish buyers with contracts for purchase and any and all paperwork associated with the sale and transfer of ownership of sold alpaca, including Alpaca Registry, Incorporated (ARI) certificates.
3. Sellers will be paid directly by the buyers. Commissions will be paid by sellers to Illusion Ranch Alpacas on the date of the auction.
4. Only alpacas registered or listed with the ARI will be accepted in this sale. Enclosed is my check for \$750 for each alpaca entered to pay the consignment fee. Make all checks payable to Illusion Ranch Alpacas. This fee is non-refundable and nontransferable for any reason once confirmation is made, unless the event is cancelled.
5. All alpacas must be micro-chipped and identified by microchip number on their health documents.
6. I will be charged a selling fee of 10% of the amount of the highest bid received on this entry.

7. This entry will be reserved for the sale, and in the event it is sold prior to the sale, I will pay Illusion Ranch Alpacas 10% of the selling price in addition to the entry fee, should no substitution be available and agreed to by all parties.
8. Once the animal has been confirmed, no substitutions will be allowed without prior approval from sale management.
9. I have read, and understand and agree to all conditions of this sale as set forth in this contract. I do further attest that all information furnished regarding these entries is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that Illusion Ranch Alpacas is not responsible for errors. I agree to have absolute and complete title to all alpacas entered and guarantee the health of my consignments.
10. All alpacas in the sale must have a veterinarian signed certificate of health certifying the animal to be free from infection and contagious disease, as well as a negative test for TB, Brucellosis and BVDV. All breeding males must be checked and certified by a DVM to have both testicles present. All females selling as pregnant must be pregnancy checked by a DVM not more than 30 days before the sale and proof of pregnancy must be turned in to the sale management prior to the sale.
11. All sales constitute a contract between the buyer and seller of each animal sold. Illusion Ranch Alpacas assumes no responsibility, legal or otherwise, in regard to the sale contract.
12. All alpacas will be cataloged in random order except when a consignor enters more than one animal, these entries will be sold throughout the sale unless the consignor requests that their consignments be sold in consecutive order. Consignments will sell in the same order as they are listed in the catalog.
13. The consignor agrees to hold Illusion Ranch Alpacas or G. Robin Gilmore or Robin Gilmore Events, LLC harmless from damages in the event that unusual or unforeseen circumstances result in the change of location, change of time or date, or cancellation or similar modification of this sale.
14. All registration certificates, along with entry fees, and pictures must accompany this contract and all must be signed by the legal owner or legal agent.
15. It is the consignor's responsibility to feed and water their own alpacas at the sale site and make sure that their alpacas are brought to and shown on the sale stage and then returned to their stalls. The consignor is to furnish the buyer with a halter and lead.
16. The highest bidder will be the buyer. In case of dispute, the sole authority to settle the bid rests with the auctioneer.
17. All liability for statements made in the sale catalog rest with the consignor. Please check accuracy of statements with regards to winning, training, and ability of animal.
18. The sale management assumes no liability for loss or injury due to theft, mysterious disappearance, sickness, improper handling or act of God.
19. Any dispute shall be resolved according to Pennsylvania law.
20. IN THE EVENT I ELECT TO OFFER TERMS ON MY SALE LOT(S), I AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS, AND FREE FROM ANY LIABILITY RESULTING FROM SAID SALE ILLUSION RANCH ALPACAS OR G. ROBIN GILMORE OR ROBIN GILMORE EVENTS, LLC. I UNDERSTAND THAT I ALONE AM RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT AND COLLECTION OF THE ASSOCIATED DEBT, AND THE COMMISSION PAYMENT TO ILLUSION RANCH ALPACAS.
